


# Odisha tops mining economy charts: Assocham-Icra report

Odisha is the largest contributor to India's mining economy, accounting for around 14 per cent of the country's mining Gross Value Added (GVA) in FY25, according to a report by Assocham (The Associated Chambers of Commerce and Industry of India) and credit rating agency Icra. It was released during the recently held India Mines and Minerals Conclave 2026 in Bhubaneswar.


Gujarat ranked second with a share of 12.9 per cent, followed by Maharashtra with 12.1 per cent, Rajasthan with 9.6 per cent and Madhya Pradesh with 8.6 per cent. These five states together contributed over 57 per cent of the national mining GVA.

The report said Madhya Pradesh recorded the highest CAGR at 12.5 per cent, followed by Gujarat at 11.9 per cent and Telangana at 11.4 per cent.
