

CNG prices up ₹2/kg in Delhi, 4th hike in 15 days

Compressed natural gas (CNG) price has been hiked by ₹2 per kg to ₹83.09 in Delhi, the fourth hike in around 10 days.

In Noida, Ghaziabad and Greater Noida, CNG will now cost ₹91.7 per kg, in Gurugram ₹88.12 and Ajmer ₹92.44. On May 15, CNG rates were increased by ₹2 per kg, followed by a ₹1 hike

on May 17 and another ₹1 increase on May 23. Cumulatively, there have been four hikes, taking the prices up by ₹6 per kg. CNG would still offer up to 45 per cent savings on running cost when compared to vehicles using alternative fuel at the current level of prices.

The rise in prices of CNG will have a bearing on public transport with expectations that autos and taxis will raise prices for commuters, said ICRA.
